



2010 TECHNICAL PAPER AWARD

Call for Papers

TexITE announces its call for papers for the 2010 TexITE Technical Paper Award. This award is presented annually to recognize the outstanding technical paper prepared by a non-student member or affiliate of the Texas District (TexITE).

The submitted paper shall be prepared by either an individual or collaboration and represent initiative beyond the author or author's routine employment or educational duties. The subject of the submitted paper shall be a transportation issue or project. Paper specifications are described below.

- The length of each paper, including the abstract and references, **may not exceed 7,500 words**. Each table, figure, or photograph included in the text counts as 250 words. Authors are encouraged to keep papers to the minimum length possible. The total number of words in the paper **must** be noted on the title page. The reviewing committee will exercise its discretion to consider papers that exceed the maximum length.
- Each paper **must** have an abstract. **The abstract may not exceed 250 words**.
- The names, current affiliations, complete mailing addresses, telephone numbers, and email addresses of all authors **must** be listed on the title page.
- All papers **must** be submitted in English.

Papers should be submitted electronically to Melisa Finley, TexITE District Award Coordinator, m-finley@tamu.edu by midnight (CST) on April 30, 2010.
