Rules and Important Information

- § All submissions must be original student work.
- § The webpage must be in HTML format and compatible with Internet Explorer.
- § The webpage and all associated graphics must be able to be displayed in an offline format (i.e., there will be no internet connection).
- § Students must properly cite sources and avoid the use of copyrighted materials without permission.
- § An entry form must be submitted by **December 17, 2004**.
- § All entries become the property of TexITE (the sponsoring organization).

Contest Events

- § Judging of the entries will be done on the morning of **Friday, February 4, 2005** at the Waco Convention Center. Participants whose entry forms have been received will be notified about the time of the judging at a later date. All participants should bring their webpage materials with them at this time on either a CD or USB compatible memory stick. Computers to display the offline webpages will be provided.
- § The top three contest participants and their parents/guardians will be invited to attend a luncheon on **Friday, February 4, 2005** with TexITE (the sponsoring organization) at which time their awards will be presented.
