2.0 FINANCIAL STATUS

Section bank account balance as of December 2010 was approximately \$2,700. We purchased a new projector and screen for Section meetings which cost \$650.00 and a gift card for \$25 for the DFW Engineers social event. In addition, we sold a screen for approximately \$100.

3.0 MEMBERSHIP

The Greater Fort Worth Section currently has approximately 70 members. The Section collects the annual membership fee of \$8 ourselves (as opposed to via ITE Int'l).
