



2025 TEXAS DISTRICT FELLOWSHIPS

Call for Candidates

Up to two fellowships of \$3,000 each may be awarded annually to the two highest ranked candidates from the Texas District.

Candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Earned or will have earned a bachelor's degree by August 31, 2025.
- Already admitted or qualified for unconditional admission to a graduate study program at one of the universities within the Texas District.
- Already enrolled or eligible to begin graduate study in transportation on a full-time basis by January 2026 and not completing their graduate program prior to December 2025.
- If selected, the candidate must enter full-time graduate study in transportation within 12 months of the closing date of the application.
- Pursuing or planning to pursue a master's degree in transportation engineering or planning, with the principal course work in traffic engineering, geometric design, and/or transportation planning.

Doctoral students are not eligible to apply. If a candidate has previously received a Texas District Fellowship, he or she is not eligible to reapply.

Applications for these fellowships must include all of the following:

- A completed application.
- An essay, written by the candidate, explaining his or her reasons for pursuing a graduate degree in transportation and outlining career objectives. The essay should be no longer than 2 single-spaced typewritten pages.
- A copy of the candidate's resume, indicating academic and professional experience, awards, etc.
- A list of proposed courses for each prospective university listed on the application form.
- Two completed reference forms from the references named on the application.
- An official transcript from each university the candidate has attended or is currently attending.

Applications must be submitted electronically to Brian Moen, Texas District Award Coordinator, at awards@texite.org by 11:59 pm (CDT) on **October 31, 2025**. The TexITE Awards Committee will meet to rank the eligible candidates and select the top two individuals, as appropriate.
