

Existing Intersection of Alameda Ave. and Paisano Dr












Street View – West Roundabout


A Texas Department of Transportation plan to install two roundabouts on Alameda Avenue as part of improvements raised concerns from residents Thursday. The \$7 million project proposes roundabouts at Alameda and tion, which would include the Paisano Drive and at Alameda and Concepcion Street. The main purpose of the ber 2013. roundabouts is to relieve con-gestion and driver confusion hosted by city Rep. Emma while they drive under the Alameda Bridge and onto

Paisano, said Robert Bielek, El Paso district engineer with the Texas Department of Transportation.

The drafted design of the two roundabouts would have cross walks, medims, bicycle lanes and flashing lights to indicate when a pedestrian is crossing. If approved, the construcdemolition of the Alamoda bridge, would begin in Decem-


