

#### **Texas Transportation is in Crisis!**


- Increasing population (and vehicle miles travelled)




#### 1,000 New Residents Per Day


#### **Motor Fuel Tax Collections Flat**





#### **Gross Toll Revenues in Texas**


1995-2010 (Millions \$)




## Texas Mobility Fund Construction and Debt




## Proposition 14 Construction and Debt Service

Deterioration from inadequate maintenance



- With more tolls
- With user fees

#### **A Primer on Transportation User Fees**

**Revenue (Excluding Bond Proceeds)** 



#### **User Fees**

- State fuel user fee = 20 cents per gallon
- Federal fuel user fee = 18.4 cents per gallons
- Registration fees = \$50 per year

#### The Average Driver

- 12,000 miles per year
- 20 miles per gallon
- \$50 per year registration fee

\$280 per year

#### Not Counting . . .

- The 35% of the state user fee that goes to education and policing the highways or
- The 25% of the federal user fee that goes to mass transit (largely in other states)

\$215 per year

Or less than \$20 per month to drive on the state's highways

# A 10 cent per gallon increase in the state user fee 100% dedicated to mobility
