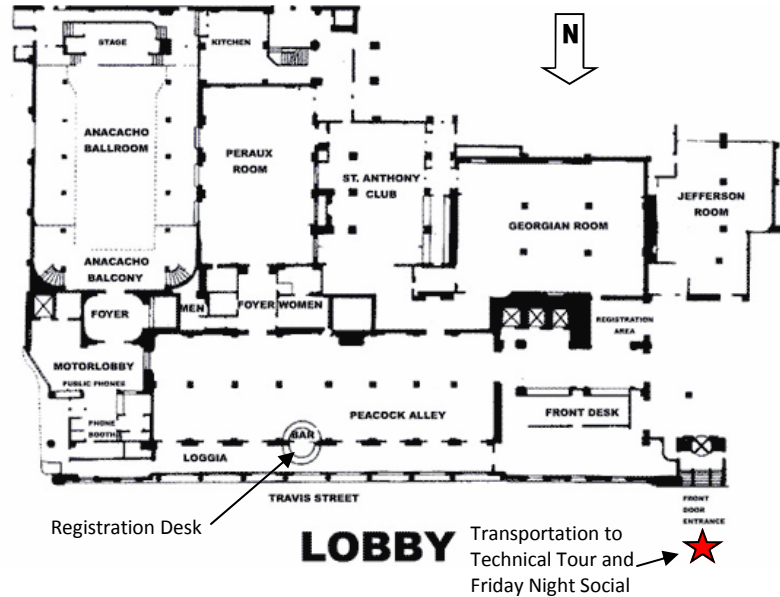

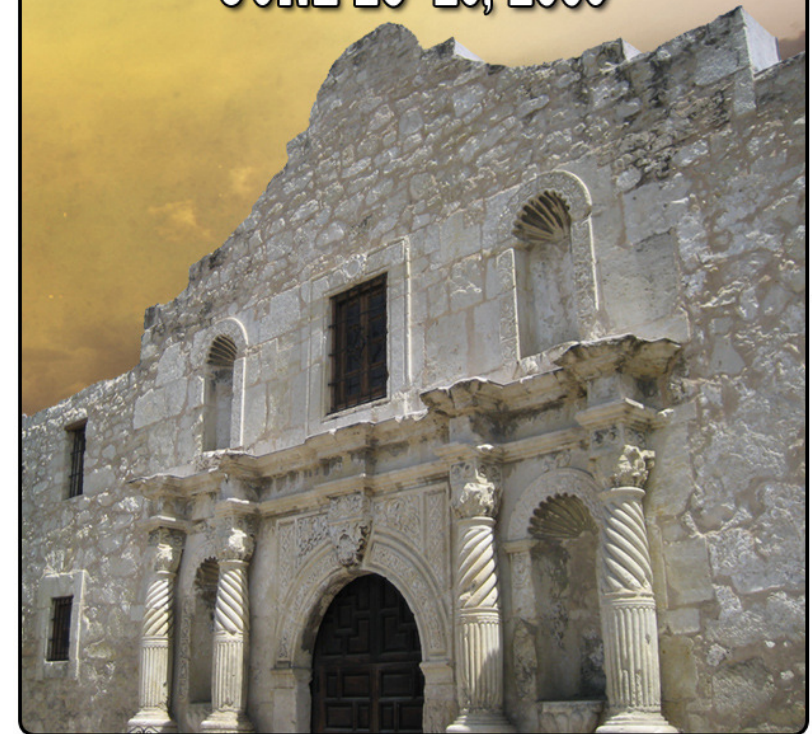

The Texas Department of Transportation is exploring the development of school speed limit zone warrants.
